



Patrick County Public Schools Celebration of Success 2010-2011 School Year

- All schools are accredited by the Commonwealth of Virginia for the 2010-2011 school year.
- **One of seven** systems statewide in which the division as a whole and each school made AYP for 2010-2011.
- **One of twelve** school systems out of 132 statewide to make AYP for 2010 – 2011.
- **One of twelve** outperforming school districts in Virginia, as indicated by Standard and Poor's in 2004-2005.
- Woolwine Elementary School awarded Distinguished Title I School for 2010 – 2011.
- **Every** classroom has a Smartboard, a distinction that few other school divisions have in Virginia.
- Patrick Springs Primary nominated by VA Dept. of Education for Blue Ribbon Program for 2010.
- Division recognized as a “Certified Green Schools Division.”
- Patrick County High School recognized by *U.S. News and World Report* as **One of the Best High Schools in the Nation** for 2009 and 2010.
 - **86%** of graduates enrolled in post-secondary education for the past four years.
 - **40** juniors and seniors have enrolled in the D² Program for the 2010-2011 school year, a program in partnership with Patrick Henry Community College in which high school students may earn a college degree and high school diploma simultaneously.
 - **28** seniors graduated with a high school diploma and an associate’s degree in June 2010 (15% of the senior class).
 - **65%** of graduates were Career and Technical Completers.
 - **60%** of graduates completed dual enrollment courses.
 - High School Principal named “**2009 Outstanding High School Principal of the Year**” for the State of Virginia.
 - Class of 2010 earned **over 1.0 million dollars** in scholarships.
- Needed additions and renovations are being completed at all of the seven schools in Patrick County!
